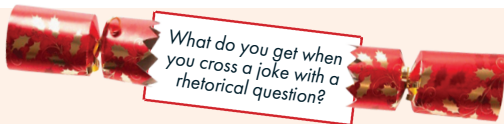


It's that time of year again

What do you call a dog who meditates? Aware wolf.

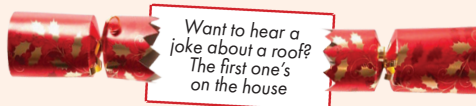
What do you call a French man wearing sandals? Philippe Fallop.
